

# Peer-to-Peer Support Training: A Collaborative Approach to Managing Traumatic Stress and Suicide Prevention

## Purpose, Scope and Terminology of Peer Support Programs \*

- 1. Demonstrate understanding of shared language around peer support methods.
- 2. Utilize evidence based concepts around the efficacy of peer support to healthcare workers.
- 3. Recognize scope of practice interventions can be utilized.

### **Trauma Informed Care: Considerations for Providers and Staff\***

- 1. Demonstrate increased awareness of factors of both past and present trauma responses.
- 2. Discuss ethical needs and considerations due to past and present trauma
- 3. Explain the physiological/internal roots of trauma, vicarious trauma, moral distress and compassion fatique.

## **Emergent Need for Psychological or Emotional Support Interventions\***

- 1. Demonstrate awareness of bias and cultural competency in interventions with peers,
- 2. Explain methods to build secure connection with peers,
- 3. Demonstrate increased knowledge of intervention skills.

## **Question, Persuade, Refer; Suicide Prevention Training\***

- 1. Describe how to interpret and respond to peers that are experiencing suicide ideation,
- 2. Recognize how to utilize referrals for actively suicidal person (non-Cook specific);
- 3. Prepare for how to appropriately engage with suicidal ideations in peers.

#### **Referrals & Employees in Crisis\***

- 1. Describe appropriate referrals (non-cook specific) for individuals in crisis
- 2. Create safe plans with interdisiciplinary teamwork

#### **Legal & Ethical Considerations\***

- 1. Explain the ethical considerations of disclosure after adverse event and referrals with peers (non-cook specific)
- 2. Identify legal resources and differentiate between priviledged and confidential conversations.
- 3. Summarize the ethical importance of appropriate interventions

#### Applying Emotional Support Interventions in Peer Interactions (Role-play Workshop)\*

- 1. Roleplay how to interpret and respond to peers that are experiencing trauma, moral distress or suicide ideation.
- 2. Identify proactive strategies to empower peers with behavioral tools and appropriate consults
- 3. Employ proven strategies for emotional peer support to improve teamwork and care delivery across interdisicplinary teams.
