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Background

- Attracting nursing graduates to pediatrics has many challenges
- · Decreased pediatric content in nursing curricula and the lack of pediatric clinical experiences can deter students from pursuing careers in our specialty

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Challenges

- Decreasing pediatric content and exposure
- Difficulty finding clinical placements
- Geographic distance from children's hospitals
- Lack of pediatrics in community hospitals
- Lack of resources for Pediatric Mental Health
- Myth you have to start with adult med-surg

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
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
Pathway Features

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Pediatric Nurse Scientist: Pediatric nurse scientists (or nurse researchers) investigate how to make health care better for kids, families, communities. Sometimes they explore how to better support nurses. Whatever topic they tackle, they use evidence and best practices to transform outcomes. <u>Get</u> your plan.

Educator/Faculty: Academic educators and faculty members bring pediatric nursing practice to life in classrooms and clinical settings. They develop curricula and instruct, evaluate, and advise students to shape future careser. <u>Nurse Entrapreneur</u>: A pediatric nurse entrapreneur is a creative self-starter who translates their clinical expertise into a successful business in the health care industry. 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

Becoming a Certified Pediatric Nurse (CPN) is a professional millestone for RNs in a vide variety of settings nar ordes who want to demonstrate their knowledge in and commitment to pediatric nursing. <u>Set your plan</u>.

<u>Clinical Nurse Leader</u>: A pediatric clinical nurse leader wants to answer questions like "Is it effective?" and "Is it efficient?" with the end goal of improving health outcomes for children, adolescents, and young adults. They identify gaps in health care, ways to decrease costs, and priorities so they can communicate findings to leaders and implement changes. <u>Set your plan</u>.

Pediatric Nurse Practitioner: A pediatric nurse practitioner (PNP) has graduate level education to provide health care for children, adolescents, and young adults. They work in different settings like hospitals, private practice, or specialty clinics to promote overall health and well-being. <u>Get your plan</u>.

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
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

Group Activity Example

Role-playing Scenarios

Have each group prepare and perform short role-playing scenarios demonstrating how a pediatric nurse fulfilling the assigned role might interact with children, families, and colleagues. Advise that specific skills and knowledge required for each career opportunity should be made evident through the role-play scenarios. spr

Individual Activity Example

Portfolio Development:

Instruct nursing students to create a career portfolio with information about pediatric nursing career opportunities. 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Individual Activity Example

Career Exploration Stations

Set up different stations in the classroom, each representing a specific pediatric nursing career opportunity. Provide each student with a Career Exploration Survey.... Have the nursing students rotate through the stations, where they can analyze the infographics, ask questions, and discuss the roles and responsibilities associated with each career path. After exploring each station, students complete the Career Exploration Survey.

- 3. What are your personal career goals at this time?


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


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
