- Describe progress to date and outcomes


Implementation Strategies


- Defined diversity, equity, and inclusion
- Evaluated mission statement and core values and submitted recommendations to the Board
- Surveyed members' perceptions of diversity, equity, and inclusion related to SPN (2021)
 - 7% of members participated (n = 209)
 - Participants were mostly white, female, had a bachelor degree and worked in the hospital setting.
 - Opportunities existed for improvement in communication, education, visibility of initiatives, and inclusive leadership development
- Incorporated DEI related presentations in the national conference and member educational webinars.






2023 Follow-up Survey Results (N = 93)
